BANDS: 80 M AND 40 M SIMULTANEOUSLY

RECOMMENDED FREQUENCIES:

CW: 3510 - 3560 KHZ SSB: 3600 - 3650 and 3700 - 3750 KHZ

7010 - 7040 KHZ 7050 - 7150 KHZ

CLASSES: A - SINGLE OPERATOR, CW AND SSB (MIXED MODE)

B - SINGLE OPERATOR, SSB ONLYC - SINGLE OPERATOR, CW ONLY

D - SINGLE OPERATOR, LOW POWER (<=100 WATTS), MIXED MODE

E - SINGLE OPERATOR, QRP (<=10 WATTS), MIXED MODE F - MULTI OPERATOR, CW AND SSB (MIXED MODE)

G - SWL

ESTONIAN STATIONS CAN WORK ALL THE STATIONS WHO PARTICIPATE IN THE CONTEST (BOTH, ES STATIONS AND NON-ES STATIONS), NON-ES STATIONS CAN WORK ONLY ES STATIONS. FOR ALL CLASSES - ONLY ONE SIGNAL ON AIR AT ANY GIVEN TIME!

REPORT: RS(T) AND SERIAL NUMBER, STARTING 001

(SERIAL NUMBER IS CONTINUOUS, **NOT** SEPARATE PER BAND!)

DUPES: DUPLICATE QSOs (i.e. QSOs WITH SAME STATION) ARE ALLOWED **ONCE IN CW**

AND **ONCE IN SSB** DURING **EVERY FULL HOUR PERIOD** (e.g. 5:00-5:59 etc) ON BOTH BANDS. SO, YOU CAN WORK A CERTAIN STATION MAX **4 TIMES** WITHIN

AN HOUR – 2 QSO-s ON 80M AND 2 QSO-s ON 40M.

QSO POINTS: CW QSO --- 2 POINTS AND SSB QSO --- 1 POINT.

MULTIPLIER: ES REGION PREFIX (ES1 -- ES0) ON EACH BAND AND MODE (MAX. 40).

SCORING: FINAL SCORE IS THE SUM OF QSO POINTS COLLECTED ON THE 2 BANDS

TIMES TOTAL MULTIPLIER.

LOGGING: THE LOGS SHOULD CONTAIN ALL VALID QSO DATA AND NECESSARY DATA

ABOUT THE PARTICIPANT (PLEASE INDICATE YOUR CLASS!). TIME IN UTC, ALLOWED TIME ACCURACY 5 MIN. CABRILLO LOGS CREATED BY MOST LOGGING PROGRAMMES ARE EXPECTED BY THE COMMITTEE. N1MM+ WITH SPECIALLY CREATED UDC-FILE IS RECOMMENDED FOR THIS CONTEST – SEE
