Quick History - Early Beginnings & Pre-WWII Era

- **Predecessors**: Amateur radio in Latvia traces back to the early 20th century, when enthusiasts began experimenting with home-built transmitters and receivers.
- Latvian Radio Society: In the 1930s, the "Latviešu Radio Biedrība" (LRB) helped to organize and legitimize the first structured amateur radio activities.
- **Growth & Innovation:** By the late 1930s, many Latvian operators had their own callsigns and participated in regional communication tests, laying foundations for a strong technical community.

Quick History - Post-War Period & Reestablishment

- World War II & Soviet Era: After WWII, independent clubs were suppressed under the Soviet regime. Amateur radio continued under strict regulations, mainly through DOSAAF (Voluntary Society for Cooperation with the Army, Aviation, and Fleet).
- Revival in the 1990s: With Latvia regaining independence in 1991, enthusiastic operators including Juris Trukšāns (YL2CR) helped revive amateur radio organizations, leading to the formation (or re-formation) of LRAL.
- Modern *LRAL*: Today, *LRAL* preserves historical callsigns and traditions from its pre-war heritage, actively promotes amateur radio education, and represents Latvian amateurs in international forums (IARU).
